TOP 10 QUESTIONS TO ASK

Every bride (and groom) wants the perfect wedding day. With so much advertising competing for the couple's attention, it's difficult to know which vendor to choose. But with careful planning, asking the right questions and following your gut instinct, everything is sure to turn out just fine.

- 1) What's the history and wedding experience of the company?
- 2) Is the business licensed, bonded and insured?
- 3) Are you involved in your local/national industry organizations?

Let's face it, if a company is true blue about their industry, they will be involved in their industry organizations.

4) Does the vendor have pictures of their work?

The vendors should have pictures of their actual work, not pictures of what they think they can do. Keep in mind, most vendors are not professional photographers or IT folks, so don't be turned off if the pictures aren't perfect. They may not be great at taking pictures but that doesn't mean they're not great at what they do.

5) Has the vendor done business at your wedding venue?

If yes, great. Find out what they liked about the venue and what they would improve. If not, no problem. As long as they are willing to do a site visit prior to your big day?

6) What's Included in the Contract?

Don't be shy. This is your hard earned money we're talking about. If there is fine print, read it. And ask about extra fees up front...BEFORE the contract is signed.

7) What's the company Contingency Plan?

Although you plan the perfect day, some things out of your control like traffic or the weather. Ask the vendor what they did the last time something went wrong.

8) May I have 3-5 references, please?

In addition to the company website and other social media pages with reviews or testimonials, ask for references. You can talk to a review but it won't answer back.

9) What would you like to ask me?

Remember, this isn't just a one way interview. The vendor doesn't have to do business with you even if you may want to do business with them.

10) Are you comfortable with this vendor?

Perhaps this is the most important question of all. If you are not comfortable with the vendor or something just doesn't seem right then back away. Don't allow yourself to be rushed into buying. Ask for a second (or third) sit down and try again. After all, this is your big day and ultimately your decision.
